A fee of 50% of the full fee will be charged to secure a booked place for the maximum of a 2 week period in any calendar year in addition to the Christmas break. This charge will be eligible for any Australian government assistance as an allowable absence. (DECD Rural Care Fee Schedule 2013).

Staff will ask you to sign a holiday notice form.
